Cal Water MPS Station 6 Potable Water Tank Replacement Project

The City Council approved the California Water Service (Cal Water) Category 3 grading permit application for a project to replace an abandoned underground water tank located on Cal Water's property on Crystal Springs Road near the intersection of Alameda de las Pulgas. The project includes a new water tank, which will be primarily underground with just 3 feet above ground, and new landscaping. The new water tank will have the capacity to hold up to approximately 3 million gallons of water and will provide water to over 50,000 connections in the San Mateo Bayshore District, and also emergency water to the Town, if needed. The off-haul of earth materials will result in increased traffic in the vicinity over the next several months. Construction vehicles will be primarily utilizing San Mateo streets. Mitigation measures will reduce impacts associated with dust and traffic.
