RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYORS TO SIGN AND ADOPT THE JOINT  
POWERS AGREEMENT FORMING THE CENTRAL COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT

**Summary:** After several years of discussion and a highly successful six-month trial program, the cities of Hillsborough and Burlingame can consider merging Fire Departments. The data related to a combined Fire Department has been previously presented to both City Councils. This data has documented the excellent Fire and Paramedic services that will continue for both cities. In addition, extensive financial data has also projected substantial on-going savings for both Hillsborough and Burlingame. If approved, this will be the first merger of Fire Departments since the South County merger in 1979.

**Recommendation:** Adopt the resolution authorizing the Mayors to sign the Joint Powers Agreement creating the Central County Fire Department.

2. Mayor O'Mahony – Motion and vote to adopt resolution.
3. City Councils sign the resolution
4. Mayor Regan and Mayor O'Mahony sign the Joint Powers Agreement
