Notes: CDF wildland/urban interface threat mapping reflects relative risk to areas of population density from wildfire. Risk is expressed in terms of a "Threat to Community" value, with potential values ranging from -14 (Little or no Threat to community areas with average density of 1 housing unit per 20 acres or less) to +44 (Extreme Threat to community areas with average density of 1 unit per acre or more). Threat values in the Hillsborough area range from 13 to 34, which are all between the Moderate and Very High level, with most places classified as High or Very High threat.
