#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. RESOLUTION APPOINTING THOMAS M. KASTEN, CHRISTINE M. KROLIK AND JESS E. (JAY) BENTON TO THE HILLSBOROUGH CITY COUNCIL (Deputy City Clerk)

**Summary:** Only three persons, Thomas M. Kasten, Christine M. Krolik and Jess E. (Jay) Benton have filed nomination papers for the three (3) City Council seats to be filled at the November 4, 2008 General Municipal Election. The San Mateo County Elections Official has certified the necessary number of signatures filed on the nomination papers for all three candidates. Pursuant to Section 10229 of the California Elections Codes, the City Council may appoint such nominees to such respective offices.

If appointed, Thomas M. Kasten, Christine M. Krolik and Jess E. (Jay) Benton will take office at the first regular meeting of the City Council held in December 2008.

**Recommendation:** Adopt the resolution appointing Thomas M. Kasten, Christine M. Krolik and Jess E. (Jay) Benton to the Town of Hillsborough City Council.

2. RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE THREE ELECTION RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT THE JULY 11, 2008 MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL (Deputy City Clerk)

**Summary:** Three persons filed nomination papers for the three City Council seats to be filled at the November 4, 2008 election. The nominees were appointed to the three seats to be filled to avoid the expense of an election.

Since an election in November 2008 is no longer required, the three resolutions passed by the City Council on July 11, 2008 regarding the calling of the general municipal election, consolidation with the statewide general election, and the County's services in canvassing election returns are no longer appropriate.

**Recommendation:** Adopt the resolution modifying the three election resolutions passed at the July 11, 2008 meeting of the City Council regarding the November 4, 2008 election.
