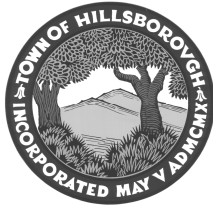

AGENDA STAFF REPORT

ITEM SUBJECT: RESOLUTION APPOINTING MARIE CHUANG AND LAURENCE MAY TO THE HILLSBOROUGH CITY COUNCIL

SUMMARY: Only two persons, Marie Chuang and Laurence May, have filed nomination papers for the two (2) City Council seats to be filled at the November 2, 2010 General Municipal Election. The San Mateo County Elections Official has certified the necessary number of signatures filed on the nomination papers for the two candidates. Pursuant to Section 10229 of the California Elections Code, the City Council may appoint such nominees to such respective offices.

If appointed, Marie Chuang and Laurence May will take office at the first regular meeting of the City Council held in December 2010.

FISCAL IMPACT: Cancelling the election will save the Town a roughly estimated cost of consolidated election services of approximately \$15,000.

ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES: There are no environmental issues associated with this agenda item.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HILLSBOROUGH
APPOINTING MARIE CHUANG AND LAURENCE MAY
TO THE HILLSBOROUGH CITY COUNCIL**

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the Town of Hillsborough, County of San Mateo, State of California, that:

WHEREAS, two (2) City Council seats are to be filled in the regular municipal election scheduled to be held on November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, during the candidate filing period, only two persons, Marie Chuang and Laurence May, timely filed nomination papers for those two City Council seats by the conclusion of the filing deadline on August 11, 2010; and

WHEREAS, as required by Section 10229 of the California Elections Code, the City Elections Official (the City Clerk) has (i) submitted a certificate of these facts to the City Council and informed the City Council that it may either appoint the persons nominated or hold the election and (ii) posted a notice of these facts and the courses of action available to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, appointing such nominees pursuant to Section 10229 of the California Elections Code rather than holding an election will save the Town the cost of the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. Marie Chuang and Laurence May are hereby appointed to the City Council in lieu of election.
2. Pursuant to Section 10229 and 10263 of the California Elections Code and Section 36503 of the California Government Code, Marie Chuang and Laurence May shall take office at the December 2010 regular meeting of the City Council (that being the meeting at which the City Council would have adopted the official canvass of votes at the municipal election had there been one) and shall serve exactly as if elected at the November 2, 2010 municipal election for the two City Council seats.
3. This resolution shall be printed and posted upon the three official bulletin boards of the Town of Hillsborough.

AGENDA STAFF REPORT

ITEM SUBJECT: RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE THREE ELECTION RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT THE JUNE 14, 2010 MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

SUMMARY: Two persons filed nomination papers for the two City Council seats to be filled at the November 2, 2010 election. The nominees were appointed to the two seats to be filled to avoid the expense of an election.

Since an election in November 2010 is no longer required, the three resolutions passed by the City Council on June 14, 2010 regarding the calling of the general municipal election, consolidation with the statewide general election, and the County's services in canvassing election returns are no longer appropriate.

FISCAL IMPACT: Cancelling the election will save the Town a roughly estimated cost of consolidated election services of approximately \$15,000.

ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES: There are no environmental issues associated with this agenda item.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HILLSBOROUGH
MODIFYING THE THREE ELECTION RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT THE
JUNE 14, 2010 MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL**

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the Town of Hillsborough, County of San Mateo, State of California, that:

WHEREAS, the Town's general municipal election was uncontested because only two persons were nominated for the two City Council seats to be filled at the November 2, 2010, regular municipal election; and

WHEREAS, as authorized by Section 10229 of the California Elections Code and in order to avoid the expense of an election, the City Council appointed the two nominees to the two seats to be filled (to take office in December 2010) at the City Council's Special Meeting held on August 19, 2010; and

WHEREAS, many of the provisions of the three election resolutions, listed below, passed by the City Council at its June 14, 2010 meeting are, therefore, no longer needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Town's general municipal election, which was consolidated with the statewide general election on November 2, 2010, shall not be held because the City Council has filled all open offices by appointment in accordance with California Election Code provisions for uncontested elections.
2. The City Clerk shall inform the San Mateo County Elections Official and Board of Supervisors that there will be no general municipal election for the Town of Hillsborough on November 2, 2010, for the reasons explained above and that the County's services in canvassing election returns for the Town of Hillsborough will not be needed.
3. The City Clerk shall not execute the service agreement between the County of San Mateo and the Town of Hillsborough regarding the County's services in connection with the general municipal election.
4. The provisions of this resolution shall control over any contrary provisions contained in Resolution 10-42 Calling the General Municipal Election, etc., Resolution 10-43 Requesting the Consolidation of the City Election with the Statewide General Election, and Resolution 10-44 Requesting the County to Canvass the Returns, etc., passed at the June 14, 2010, meeting of the City Council; provided, however, that nothing in this Resolution shall be deemed to

have altered the November 2, 2010, date of the general municipal election for purposes of calculating applicable filing periods, posting periods, deadlines, and other such dates required by law regarding the Town's general municipal election and matters related to it.

5. This resolution shall be printed and posted upon the three official bulletin boards of the Town of Hillsborough.
