

ORDINANCE NO. 693

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 13.20.040 AND 13.20.020 OF THE
HILLSBOROUGH MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADOPT MAXIMUM WATER SERVICE
RATES AND MAXIMUM METER SERVICE CHARGES FOR
THE NEXT FIVE YEARS EFFECTIVE APRIL 12, 2011**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HILLSBOROUGH, AS FOLLOWS:


1. Section 13.20.040 is hereby amended to modify the Town's existing water service rates to a level not-to-exceed the amounts shown on the following table. The Town may charge rates at or below the rates shown, but may not charge rates in excess of the rates shown below. Such rates are to be effective April 12, 2011, and are to remain in effect for all subsequent fiscal years until amended.



2. Section 13.20.020 is hereby amended to modify the Town's existing water meter service charges to a level not-to-exceed the amounts shown on the following table. The Town may charge meter service charges at or below the adopted amounts, but not in excess of the maximum charges shown below. Such maximum charges are to be effective April 12, 2011, and are to remain in effect for all subsequent fiscal years until amended.

3. The Town's outstanding bond issues contain debt service requirements which in the case of water are in part dependent on a certain level of water consumption. The Town's consumption level is trending downward. Therefore, it is essential for the Town to realize the increase in revenues from the aforescribed increase in water rates as soon as possible. Accordingly, this urgency ordinance is passed upon introduction and public hearing and will take effect immediately upon passage on April 12, 2011. The ordinance shall be printed and posted upon the three official bulletin boards of the Town of Hillsborough.
