Welcome to the Town of Hillsborough!

On behalf of the Mayor, City Council and Town staff, we welcome you to Hillsborough. We are pleased that you have chosen to live here. Hillsborough's rural charm, quiet atmosphere, excellent public and private schools, outstanding police, fire and emergency services, and citizen involvement make for a very caring and friendly community.

This letter is to enlighten you about the Town and the many services we have to offer. Hillsborough was incorporated as a city on May 5, 1910. Hillsborough has an area of 6.23 square miles and is home to approximately 11,000 residents. The Town is known for its rural character with a tree-studded landscape dominated by large homes providing residents a quiet escape from the congestion of surrounding cities on the Peninsula. Hillsborough residents have continually worked to preserve the Town's relaxed country setting. With only a few traffic lights and streetlights, trees, flowers and shrubbery continue to typify the Town's landscape.

The Town is a general law city operating with a Council/Manager form of government. Policy-making and legislative authority are vested in the governing five-member City Council, which consists of a Mayor, Vice Mayor and three Councilmembers. The public is invited to attend the City Council meetings held on the second Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at Hillsborough Town Hall, 1600 Floribunda Avenue. Agendas for these meetings can be found on the Town's website.

Hillsborough is a full service city with over 70 staff members to serve you. The Town provides essential services including police and fire protection, building permitting and inspection, land use management, and maintenance of roads, public facilities, water, sewer and storm drainage infrastructures. The City Manager is responsible for carrying out policies enacted by the City Council and for the day-to-day operations of the Town by overseeing the Finance, Building and Planning, Fire, Police and Public Works Departments.
