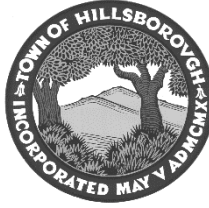

CITIZENS COMMUNICATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The minutes for May were continued until the next meeting. There was not a CCAC meeting in June.

V. PRESENTATION: Town Council Update

PG&E gave a presentation to the Council. They are testing the gas lines off of Skyline Blvd. near 280. PG&E is doing safety improvements through out the state. High definition cameras are being installed to help spot wildfires. They have created a safety app to help people notify PG&E of concerns.

The draft for the Housing Elements will be released August 4th. A postcard will be sent to all

residents to inform them with the URL to the draft and the dates for the remaining meetings. Once the draft has been released, there is a 45 day review period. The comment period ends September 19. Two public meetings will be held to discuss the contents of the draft. The timeline is determined by the State of California.

Highlights to the June Council meeting included adopting the budget, and the cost of the San Mateo water waster treatment plant.
