

[Licensing Agreement with the Burlingame Country Club](#)

The City Council approved a license agreement with the Burlingame Country Club (BCC) to explore the possibility of creating a pedestrian path and a landscaped area along the westside of the 500 to 700 block of Eucalyptus Avenue. The Hillsborough Beautification Foundation (HBF) and Town residents have expressed interest in partnering with the Town to design and fund a pathway along road shoulder and adjacent to the paved surface. The agreement will give the Town legal authority over the proposed pathway area, which was previously the property of BCC, and will allow HBF to seek landscape design professionals to create a landscaping plan, which will include a pathway, trees, and shrubbery.

In the next few months, Town staff will work in coordination with HBF and BCC to conduct an environmental review, develop a project plan, formulate a project budget, conduct a public outreach campaign, and develop a design that is supported by the community.

Once these steps have been completed, staff will bring the item back to the City Council in April 2018 to consider the full project.

The playground equipment in Vista Park will get a facelift in early 2018! The City Council adopted a resolution awarding the Vista Park Playground Renovations project to Community Playgrounds, Inc.

Along with the installation of new equipment for the three playground areas that meet updated State and Federal safety standards, the rubber surfacing will be replaced and additional drainage will be installed.



The project is expected to begin in February 2018, weather permitted, and last for approximately three months. All three playground areas will be closed during construction while the rest of the park stays open.
