Wireless Permit Applications Public Hearing

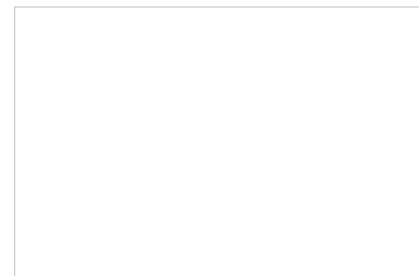
The City Council held a public hearing for the appeal by Crown Castle regarding the City Manager's decision on the 16 wireless communications facilities (WCF) applications. Representatives from Crown Castle gave a presentation and about 30 residents addressed the Council at the public hearing.

After the public hearing was closed, the City Council deliberated and direction was given to staff to prepare written finding(s) referencing substantial evidence in the Town's written administrative record for adoption as final action at the Council's next meeting. A Regular Meeting will be held on **March 26th** at **6:00pm** in the Town Hall Council Chambers (1600 Floribunda Avenue) where the City Council will make a final decision on the appeal.

Hillsborough Beautification Foundation

Tori Hazelrig, Co-President of the Hillsborough Beautification Foundation (HBF), provided an annual presentation for HBF, which is celebrating its 20th anniversary in 2018. Since its inception, HBF has improved, maintained, and supported over 144 sites in Hillsborough to accomplish the overall mission of enhancing the beauty of the Town's landscapes, encouraging community engagement, and civic pride.



HBF raises funds through donations in order to transform public spaces such as empty lots, traffic islands, and school entrances into landscaped areas that enhance the beauty of Hillsborough. Sites slated for improvement are often selected based upon requests from residents and approved through HBF committees. HBF has many ongoing projects such as the Walnut Avenue Parking Lot, Vista Park Improvements, and updating the 28 Town entrance signs.

2017 Street Resurfacing Project Completed

The City Council adopted a resolution accepting the 2017 Street Resurfacing Project as complete. The Public Works Department, along with the awarded contractor G. Bortolotto & Co., Inc., resurfaced approximately 30 miles of roadway in Hillsborough.

The primary factor for selecting roadways for rehabilitation is based on the Pavement Condition Index (PCI) of each roadway. PCI is a measure of a street's condition derived through field inspections that utilize scoring criteria developed by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) pavement management program. The 2017 project raised the Town's overall PCI score from 78 to about 80, which rates as "Very Good to Excellent" by the MTC.

Just 6 years ago the Town's PCI was 71/72, ranking near the bottom for municipalities in the County of San Mateo. Through the City Council's support, increased budgets and revisions to the municipal code to prevent unplanned contractor projects, Hillsborough has moved up to #3 in the County. Staff has leveraged existing funds and have secured several roadway grants to help boost the Town's ratings. Having excellent roadways is a goal that Town staff embraces.

The Street Resurfacing Project is an ongoing Capital Improvement Plan project. The 2019 Street Resurfacing Project is currently in design. Staff anticipates that the construction phase of this project will commence in Spring 2019 and be substantially completed by the end of the Summer.
