

Program Chair Margi Power gave an update on the local Leadership program and its goals and vision going forward. Leadership provides individuals from business, civic and nonprofit sectors with a framework for engagement in the communities of Hillsborough, San Mateo, Foster City, and Burlingame. Hillsborough has had numerous graduates including Town staff, councilmembers and residents.



Ms. Power shared the program's vision for the future. In the short term, the Leadership Board of Directors is focused on improving the curriculum, alumni outreach and communication/promotion efforts. In the long term, goals include improving financial stability (increasing fundraising capabilities), acquiring additional staffing support and expanding program offerings.
