WATER CONSERVATION REBATE PROGRAMS

The Town partners with the Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency (BAWSCA) to offer rebates to Hillsborough residents who install water conservation measures both inside and outside their home.



Hillsborough currently participates in the **Lawn Be Gone!** program that promotes the installation of

TOWN HALL A/V UPGRADE PROJECT

The City Council awarded a contract to Conti Corporation for the Town Hall Audio/Visual (A/V) System Upgrade Project. The project consists of replacing the A/V system in the Council Chambers and includes various A/V improvements in the Town Hall lobby and conference room. The new equipment will focus on greater accessibility and quality, and have the capability to be upgraded further should additional technological improvements be needed in the future.

Construction is expected to begin in April with completion by June. During this time, certain Hillsborough Recreation classes and other events that are usually held in the Council Chambers may be moved to other facilities.
