RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION: CAROLINE SERRATO



The City Council presented Hillsborough Police Captain Caroline Serrato with a Resolution of Appreciation for 23 years of service at the Town of Hillsborough. Captain Serrato began her career at Hillsborough in 1996 and was the Town's first School Resource Officer. She went on to become the Town's first female Police Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain.

The District not only provides mosquito control, but also handles a variety of other vectors such as ticks, cockroaches, yellow jackets, wasps, rodents and raccoons. Hillsborough residents can call the District at (650) 344-8592 for abatement recommendations and on-site assistance.

STREET RESURFACING PROJECT

The City Council awarded a contract to G. Bortolotto & Co., Inc. for the 2019 Street Resurfacing Project. The Town conducts street resurfacing projects biennially to rehabilitate damaged pavement sections and to provide preventative maintenance. This year's roadway project will improve over 16 miles of the Town's roadways utilizing rubberized asphalt, conventional asphalt, micro-surfacing and crack sealing as preventative maintenance.

The project is expected to commence in May 2019. Residents in the project areas will be notified in advance of potential impacts such as road closures and detours. Project information will also be posted on the Public Works' [current projects page](#).
