WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE ORDINANCE

The City Council adopted an ordinance revising the Town's Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) code. The revision expands Hillsborough's WUI Program to address fire and safety standards within the Town's WUI areas.

The ordinance was first introduced at the May 13th City Council meeting and is the product of City Council Study Sessions and community meetings.

FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET ADOPTION

The City Council approved the Town's Operating and Capital budget for fiscal year 2019-2020. The budget was developed through a collaborative effort that included all Town departments, the Financial Advisory Committee, and the City Council through Study Sessions.

The budget appropriations are \$56.9 million for all funds, which is a decrease of 4% from the fiscal year 2018-2019 projection. Timing of various capital projects accounts for most of the decrease.
