The Town received the Government Finance Officers Association's (GFOA) Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 and the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for the Fiscal Year that ended June 30, 2018.

The GFOA is a national nonprofit organization for government finance professionals. The Town has received these two awards for the past 17 years.

GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN ADOPTION



The City Council approved the adoption of the Town's Green Infrastructure (GI) Plan, which will help guide the identification, prioritization, design, implementation, tracking and reporting of GI projects within the Town. GI provides a network for alleviating climate and urban challenges by 'building with nature.' Development of green methods to combat wet weather impacts allows the community to grow and build with cost-effective, resilient approaches to managing water quality.

The adoption of a GI Plan is a requirement in the County's Municipal Regional Permit so that each jurisdiction can demonstrate how it will shift away from traditional 'gray' infrastructure, which typically channels polluted runoff without proper treatment.
