Donation station available at Town Hall

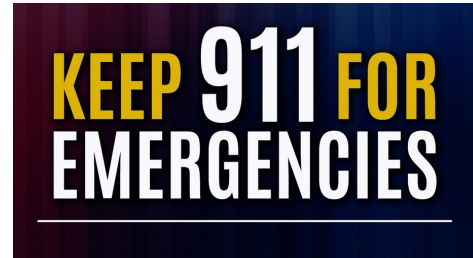
