**San Mateo County to formally ask the State for a variance to move forward in reopening**

The San Mateo County Board of Supervisors today voted to ask the State for permission to re-open large sectors of the local economy, including dine-in restaurants, hair salons and gyms. For now, the current County health order remains in effect while the State reviews the request.



In the 5-0 vote, the Board directed President Warren Slocum to send a letter to the State supporting an [attestation](#) of County Health Officer Dr. Scott Morrow that the County can satisfy the readiness criteria outlined by the State's [Resilience Roadmap](#).

If the variance is approved by the State, Dr. Morrow will issue a revised Shelter In Place order, outlining the health and safety measures businesses must follow in order to open. According to the Resilience Roadmap, the following types of businesses may be considered for reopening with approval of the variance, subject to local guidelines:

- Dine-in restaurants
- Hair salons and barber shops
- Family entertainment centers
- Restaurants, wineries and bars
- Zoos and museums
- Gyms and fitness centers
- Hotels (for tourism and individual travel)
- Cardrooms
- Campgrounds and outdoor recreation
- Schools and day camps

### **Multiple COVID-19 testing locations accepting appointments**



## San Mateo County COVID-19 case update

San Mateo County Health provides a weekly COVID-19 data update every Friday on their [data dashboard page](#). As of June 11, 2020, there have been 2,533 confirmed COVID-19 cases in the County. There are 14 confirmed cases in Hillsborough, which is an increase of 2 cases from last week. Thank you to Hillsborough residents for continuing to follow County guidelines for sheltering in place, face coverings and social distancing.


