County Board of Supervisors encourages employers to offer telecommuting

Yesterday, the County Board of Supervisors approved a resolution to encourage employers to offer eligible employees the option to telecommute "to protect and advance environmental air quality and ease traffic congestion" in San Mateo County.

The [resolution](#) references the major improvement in air quality in the Bay Area due to the majority of workers working from home during the COVID-19 pandemic.

General Municipal Election

A General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the purpose of electing three members of the Town of Hillsborough's City Council. The term of office will be for four years beginning in December 2020. A candidate must be a resident of the Town of Hillsborough and a registered voter of the Town at the time nomination papers are issued.



The nomination period for election to the office of City Councilmember will be from 8:00am on Monday, July 13, 2020, to 12:30pm on Friday, August 7, 2020. If a qualified incumbent does not file nomination papers by 12:30pm on Friday, August 7, 2020, the nomination period will be extended for non-incumbents only until 5:30pm on Wednesday, August 12, 2020.

Nomination papers will be available after 8:00am on Monday, July 13, 2020, from the Hillsborough City Clerk's Office by appointment only.
