Wireless communication facilities - proposed revisions to Design Standards

Revisions to Design Standards for wireless communication facilities (WCFs) and other infrastructure deployments will go before the City Council for consideration. The revisions are a result of multiple meetings held between November 2019 and June 2020 with Town staff, legal counsel and the Wireless Communications Advisory Committee (WCAC) to conduct an in-depth review of the Town's existing WCF Design Standards.

The proposed revisions are aimed to clarify ambiguities and respond to recent changes in Federal Communication Commission (FCC) regulations and stakeholder comments where appropriate while continuing to respect the Town's desire of maintaining aesthetic design

standards for the Town's unique residential community.

General Municipal Election

A General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the purpose of electing three members of the Town of Hillsborough's City Council. The term of office will be for four years beginning in December 2020. A candidate must be a resident of the Town of Hillsborough and a registered voter of the Town at the time nomination papers are issued.



The nomination period for election to the office of City Councilmember will be from 8:00am on Monday, July 13, 2020, to 12:30pm on Friday, August 7, 2020. If a qualified incumbent does not file nomination papers by 12:30pm on Friday, August 7, 2020, the nomination period will be extended for non-incumbents only until 5:30pm on Wednesday, August 12, 2020.

Nomination papers will be available after 8:00am on Monday, July 13, 2020, from the Hillsborough City Clerk's Office by appointment only.
