San Mateo County updates

Fines possible for health order violations, including refusing to wear face coverings

At Tuesday's meeting, the County Board of Supervisors approved an ordinance that allows new penalties for individuals who violate health orders, including refusing to wear a face covering in San Mateo County and commercial entities who allow these violations.

Last month, the Board adopted a resolution urging residents to comply with the state and county health orders requiring a face covering and the County ramped up its outreach efforts, particularly in hard to reach and low-income communities. At the time, Board members expressed their views that the misdemeanor punishment of fines and jail times associated with violating a health order could be too punitive and encouraged education instead.

But in the weeks since, the County has seen an uptick in cases that could be linked to social gatherings and individuals not covering their nose and mouth. Supervisors David Canepa and Warren Slocum, who jointly introduced the ordinance, said they still prefer education as a first step before imposing fines but that the public needs to understand that wearing a face covering must be non-negotiable.

Temporary eviction moratorium, repayment period extended through August 31st



The Board of Supervisors approved an amendment to Emergency Regulation 2020-001, a temporary, countywide moratorium on eviction for non-payment of rent by residential tenants directly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic through Aug. 31, 2020, and extended the time period in which delayed payments shall be made.

The action places a temporary countywide moratorium on evictions from residential units for:

(1) non-payment of rent by tenants directly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic; and



(2) certain no-fault causes unless the eviction is necessary for the health and safety of the tenant, other residents in the tenant's building, the landlord, or the landlord's family.
(3) amends repayment period for delayed payments.

General Municipal Election

A General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the purpose of electing three members of the Town of Hillsborough's City Council. The term of office will be for four years beginning in December 2020. A candidate must be a resident of the Town of Hillsborough and a registered voter of the Town at the time nomination papers are issued.



The nomination period for election to the office of City Councilmember will be from 8:00am on Monday, July 13, 2020, to 12:30pm on Friday, August 7, 2020. If a qualified incumbent does not file nomination papers by 12:30pm on Friday, August 7, 2020, the nomination period will be extended for non-incumbents only until 5:30pm on Wednesday, August 12, 2020.

Nomination papers will be available after 8:00am on Monday, July 13, 2020, from the Hillsborough City Clerk's Office by appointment only.
