City Council recap

Hillsborough's monthly City Council meeting was held virtually on Monday, June 8th. Some items from the meeting include:

Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budget Adoption:

The Fiscal Year 2020-21 Operating and Capital Budget was adopted with budget appropriations of \$59.9 million for all funds. Due to the ongoing pandemic, the Financial Advisory Committee and the City Council recommended deferring \$6.6 million of the proposed budget. These cost saving measures 'freeze' expenditures in staffing, capital projects, consulting and equipment that can be re-evaluated on a quarterly basis during the fiscal year. Report from Closed Session - Settlement with Crown Castle

The City Council has unanimously agreed to approve a settlement agreement, and associated letter agreement, with Crown Castle regarding the federal wireless dispute. As part of the settlement, the Town is not approving any applications but rather is agreeing to consider applications at a future time. Under the terms of the settlement, the number of potential sites has been reduced and the design has been modified lowering the height in certain instances. Police Chief Doug Davis provided an update on the Hillsborough Police Department (HPD) and their mutual aid efforts around the Bay Area during the recent protests. Chief Davis emphasized that the safety of Hillsborough residents remain HPD's top priority.

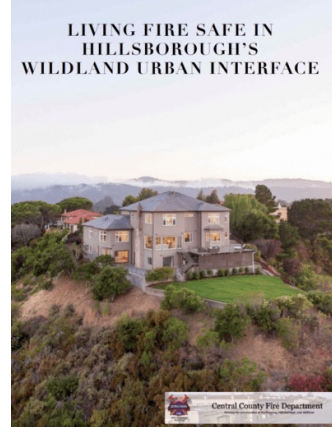
Wildland Fire Virtual Town Hall
