On March 19, 2020, California Governor Gavin Newsom issued a statewide [Stay at Home Order](#). Shelter in place is now statewide.

Any organizations that have extra PPE supplies that aren't immediately needed should consider donating them by emailing smcmeddonations@smcgov.org. PPE equipment include, but is not limited to: gloves, masks, gowns, eyewear and ventilators.



Health care providers with an active license, public health professional, members of a medical disaster response team in California who would like to volunteer, should register at healthcarevolunteers.ca.gov.

Be wary of scams

Phone and e-mail scams have been increasing as scammers try to take advantage of these unprecedented times. Recent scams have included attempting to obtain personal information by claiming to require it for:



- Getting tested for COVID-19
- Granting an extension for filing taxes
- Visiting a sick family relative in the hospital (who's not really sick)
- Signing up for unemployment benefits
