773 El Cerrito Creek Bank Repair project to begin in June - expect road closures during the day

The Town of Hillsborough will be repairing the western creek bank near 773 El Cerrito Avenue beginning in June. Residents within 500 feet of the project will receive a Public Notice letter from Hillsborough Public Works with project details and information. The project is expected to begin in June and will take approximately 10 weeks to complete.

Please expect some traffic delays during working hours (8:00am to 5:00pm, Monday-Friday) throughout the duration of the project. In several phases of construction during these working hours, a temporary full roadway closure along El Cerrito Avenue between Bowhill Road and Crystal Springs Road will be necessary with detours clearly marked.
