### Face covering information resources

San Mateo County Health [issued a new health order](#) last Friday requiring members of the public and workers at essential businesses to wear face coverings outside the home for certain activities and in places of business. The requirement is now in effect as of 8:00am this morning.

\* Surgical masks or N-95 respirators must continue to be reserved for healthcare workers and other medical first responders.
