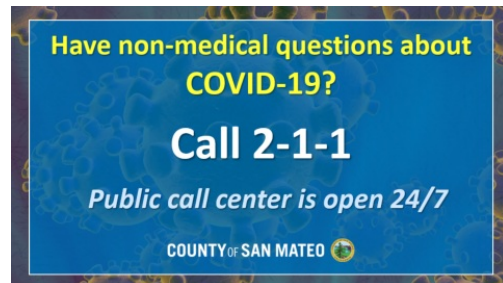

2-1-1 still available to answer your non-medical COVID-19 question

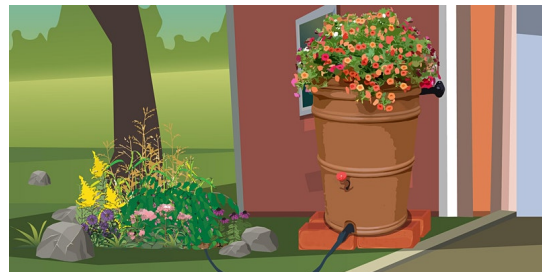

Required documents *may* include the ones listed below but please visit the San Mateo County Strong Fund site for more details and information.

- Valid business license
- Bank Statements
- Current Profit and Loss Statements
- IRS or FTB tax returns
- Proof of rent or mortgage, utility, healthcare premiums or payroll processing document

About the SMC Strong Small Business Grant Program:

- Grants up to \$10,000
- Grants can pay for payroll, operations, ongoing expenses or other costs associated with COVID-19 impacts
- Eligibility criteria - documentation **REQUIRED** for all eligibility criteria
- You may qualify for this grant regardless of whether you applied for the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP), Economic Disaster Impact Loan (EDIL) and/or other grants
- Available in English, Spanish and Chinese
- Applications *only* accepted online (to comply with physical distancing orders)
- No citizenship requirement

Everyone Counts in the 2020 Census!

As of April 23rd, Hillsborough is **#1** in San Mateo County for self-response rates at **72%** thanks to the proactiveness of our residents. The last batch of 2020 Census postcards were mailed out last week and in-person census follow-ups are tentatively scheduled to begin in the County on **June 1st**, barring any future developments with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Reminder: some residents may see their city listed as Burlingame in official documents due to federal procedures of identifying addresses by zip code. Please be assured that your submission will be counted correctly towards Hillsborough's data.
