On Saturday, the State informed San Mateo County that due to being COVID monitoring list for more than 3 days, specific indoor businesses must cease operations unless they can be modified to operate outside or by pick-up. Effective 12:01am on Sunday, August 2, 2020, the State's order to close or move outside applies to the following businesses:



- Gyms and fitness centers
- Places of worship and cultural ceremonies, like weddings and funerals
- Offices for non-critical infrastructure sectors
- Personal care services, like nail salons and body waxing
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Shopping malls

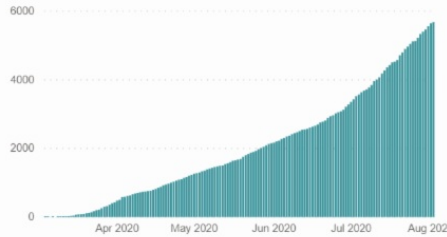

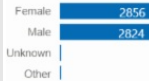

Deaths by Sex

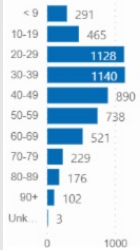

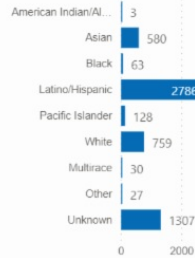


- R-eff is the average number of people an infected person will infect

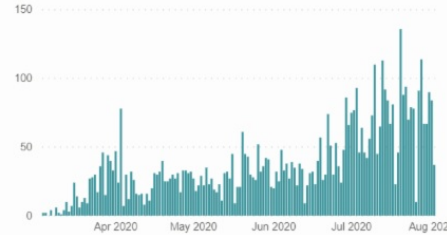
Cases by Age Group



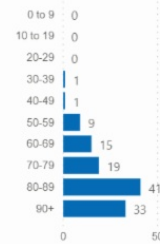
Cases by Race/Ethnicity



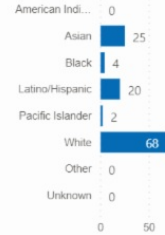
New Cases by Day
