

### San Mateo County updates

#### *State's under-reporting reflected in County's COVID-19 case count*

A significant problem with the State of California's reporting system for communicable diseases has resulted in significant underreporting of COVID-19 testing results to San Mateo County Health and local health departments statewide. SMC Health continues to work with the California Department of Public Health to identify any remaining potential data gaps to investigate, understand, and resolve additional data issues.



San Mateo County Health has updated the number of positive cases to 6,318 as of August 10, 2020.

#### *2-1-1 still taking your COVID-19 questions (and other non-medical related questions)*

Residents with non-medical, non-emergency questions about the coronavirus can call 211 or 800-273-6222 at any time, day or night. Callers from landlines and cellular telephones located within San Mateo County are connected with a trained service professional from 211, a confidential service available in 180 languages.

#### *Jury selection moved to the San Mateo Event Center*

To provide additional space for safe social distancing, the San Mateo County Superior Court will move jury selection for trials scheduled for the Hall of Justice in Redwood City to the Event Center in San Mateo. The Court may also move jury selection for trials scheduled for the Northern Branch court facility in South San Francisco to the Event Center as well.

The move to hold jury selection at the Event Center's Cypress Hall will provide large, well-ventilated space to bring potential jurors together for interviews and selection. Prospective jurors will receive reporting instructions on their jury summons once the selection process

moves to the Event Center, which is expected sometime after September 7th.








- R-eff is the average number of people an infected person will infect


Cases by Age Group




Cases by Race/Ethnicity
