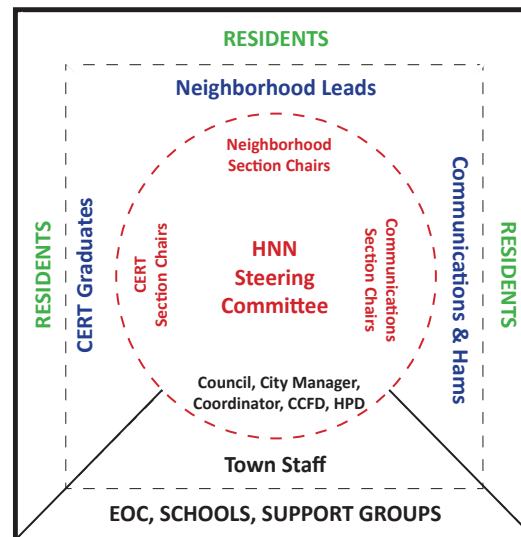
HNN offers:
