

# Hillsborough NEIGHBORHOOD NETWORK



Dear Hillsborough Resident,

The Town of Hillsborough is divided into 84 neighborhoods for emergency preparedness and volunteer, disaster response purposes. Hillsborough Neighborhood Network (HNN) is a resident, volunteer organization comprised of Neighborhood Leads, Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) graduates, and ham radio operators.

HNN is supported by the Hillsborough Police Department, Central County Fire Department and the Town of Hillsborough. The Network's objective is to assist Hillsborough residents to be self-sufficient for 72 hours in case of disaster, and to promote post-disaster resiliency and communication within neighborhoods and with emergency responders.
