3. Sign up for **SMCALERT** to receive fast information, directions, and instructions for local emergencies. Be sure to sign up for text alerts for the fastest and most efficient alert notifications!

4. **GET TO KNOW YOUR NEIGHBORS!** Throw a neighborhood a block party! Your neighbor is likely to be your first responder in the event of a multi-city, large-scale emergency. You view your neighborhood map at:

5. Make sure your home is as secure and safe as possible! The Police Department offers a free **HOME SECURITY INSPECTION PROGRAM**.

6. Get to know your neighborhood **CERT AND HAM RADIO OPERATOR**. In case of an emergency, they will have the best information.
