ABOUT THE CODE ENFORCEMENT HEARING PANEL

The Panel develops and administers a program of education and policy compliance overseeing the condition of public and private property in order to enhance the Town's heritage of natural beauty, foster its legacy of public safety and sustain the value of property for all residents. The Panel holds hearings and issues decisions regarding Code violations and hears appeals on fines and penalties. Hearings are held as needed.

The Panel is made up of up to five members who serve for a three-year term. The preferred composition of the Panel shall be residents of the Town, or persons who own property "directly or indirectly", familiar with the Town's government and municipal code, with prior experience serving on committees or boards and an interest in fostering the Town's beauty and property values.
