RE: SCADA MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT SERVICES RFP QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The Town received the following formal questions regarding its SCADA Maintenance and Support Services RFP by the question and answer deadline:

Q1. Can the Town provide the pre-proposal meeting attendee list?

Q2. Who has maintained the Town's SCADA system over the past several years?

A2. EDCCO Group has provided a majority of the maintenance and support services. The Town worked with Tesco Controls, Inc. to complete its 2020 SCADA Inventory & Assessment and has worked with various subcontractors to prime contractors during several water tank and pump station construction improvement projects.

Q3: Can you confirm that this is a prevailing wage project and not just your RFP boilerplate language?

For context, this is a public works project, administered through contract, for public works maintenance, with an expected cost to exceed \$15,000, paid using public funds.

The Town notifies contractors in its RFP and contract documents that they must comply with DIR regulations for public works projects, including prevailing wage rules and requirements.
