Water Service

To request water service, fill out an application at the Finance Department, located across from Town Hall, or download the form from the Town's website, www.hillsborough.net, and submit it by fax to 650-375-7417, by mail or in person. To cancel water service, report a change of billing address and other billing inquiries, call the Finance Department at 650-375-7402.

Garbage, Recycling & Composting

Burglary Alarm Systems

An alarm permit is required for the installation and the regulation of burglary alarm systems and is available at the Finance Department, 650-375-7402, or on the Town's website, www.hillsborough.net.

Construction

The Building and Planning Department is open Monday through Thursday from 7:30 am - 5:30 pm and Fridays from 7:30 am - 12:30 pm to answer questions and accept permit applications. Permits are issued Monday through Friday between 7:30 am and 11:30 am only. If you have any questions, contact the Building Division at 650-375-7411 or the Planning Division at 650-375-7422.

The public is welcome to attend the Architecture and Design Review Board meetings held on the first Monday of each month at 4:00 pm in the City Council Chambers at Hillsborough Town Hall.

Legal hours for construction are as follows:

- Monday-Friday: 8:00 am - 5:00 pm
Except for holidays observed by the Town
- Saturday: 10:00 am - 5:00 pm
Noise shall not exceed 70 decibels outside the property
- Sunday: No discretionary noise of any kind is permitted on Sundays and holidays

Landscaping & Trees

Landscaping review and permits are required in the following circumstances:

- Removal of a tree with a trunk having a total diameter of 36 inches or more measured at 4 feet 6 inches above natural grade
- Adding or removal of 50 cubic yards or more of soil or dirt
- Rehabilitation of more than 10,000 square feet of land
- Installation of landscaping for newly constructed residences and tear downs
- Synthetic grass in areas visible from public rights-of-way

Additionally, no tree removal *for purposes of the construction* of improvements shall occur without Town approval. For more information about the Town's ordinances regarding trees or landscaping, contact the Building and Planning Department at 650-375-7411. In case of an emergency, call 650-375-7470.

Municipal Code

Code Enforcement
